- **Parking Sticker to Parking Tag conversion has been rescheduled for September 2018.** Notification for the process of obtaining a new tag will be sent separately to all Tenants. To support this change, the THA office will be open several evenings and Saturdays to insure we accomplish this task. There will not be a charge to obtain your new mirror hanging tag if you currently have a THA Parking sticker.
- **A reminder that THA does not allow ANY swimming / wading pools (regardless of size) for ANY purpose, at ANY time.**
- Party Tents are not allowed. If you have any questions regarding something such as this, call the office before you proceed. THA Management will ask for an immediate removal of ANY unauthorized tent or party apparatus.
- Do not, at any time, attach swings, such as those used for small children, to the clothes line uprights. These posts were never designed for this purpose. THA will remove swings from the posts if found. This is a direct safety threat to any child placed in a swing attached to the clothes poles. Please don't place a child in danger with this practice.
- A reminder regarding Grass Cutting Operations. For the safety of all Tenants, please leave the area where grass cutting operations are underway. Please insure all children do not enter the area while we have grass cutting operations underway.
- Annual Apartment Inspections will be scheduled via direct Tenant letter for the Fall 2018.
- Electronics and TV recycle event June 30, 2018 from 9:00am – 12:00 noon at the Tonawanda High School parking lot. There is no charge to drop off your used electronics.
