#### Rent

Reminder: Rent is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, however you have until 4:00pm on the 8<sup>th</sup> of each month, even if the 8<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend. The late charge is \$35. Any past due charges for rent, repairs or water become unpaid rent and can incur a late fee.

#### **Yard Maintenance**

Please remove the following items by June 28, 2019:

- Birdfeeders, this is a food source for rodents and unwanted animals. If there is
  a bird feeder on the property it will be removed by THA.
- Pools, of any kind.
- Playground Equipment: swings, slides, playhouses, etc. If a child can fall off of it, it needs to be removed.
- Gazebos, screen houses, tents or 'homemade' awnings. Umbrellas that can be stowed away when not in use are permitted.
- Any and all miscellaneous items, including items that rodents and other unwanted animals could use as shelter and that are in the way of mowing operations.
