



## Fall Newsletter

- Overnight street parking ends in the City of Tonawanda on October 1, 2020 and remains in effect until March 31, 2021.
  - Please make sure you have your vehicles properly registered with the Housing Authority and you have your yellow hanging tag on your rearview window to avoid parking tickets or towing in the THA parking lots.
- It's not too early to locate your snow brush's and shovels! THA will notify tenants with a separate letter for Winter 2020 – 2021 Snow Removal Operations.
- Remove window air conditioners by November 1, 2019. Tenant will be billed a service fee due to increased gas (heat) cost each month, as well as a charge for usage over your monthly allocation of gas.
- Garbage pick-up by City of Tonawanda – Please review the garbage pickup schedule along with the recycle schedule. **Please note - Garbage cannot be put to the garbage station any earlier than 24 hours prior to pick up day.
