- On street parking begins April 1st.
- 2021 is a Tenant Representative Election year. Election will be held on July 26, 2021. Each representative will serve a 2-year term on the 7-member Board. ***Petitions for those interested in running for Tenant Representative positions will be available May 3, 2021 from the Office.***
- Grass cutting operations will soon be underway. Please make sure for your safety that you and ALL children leave and do not enter the area while the grass is being cut. Typically, we are only in that space for 5-10 minutes and it is for the safety of all tenants and personnel.
- Outside water faucets (ends of buildings) are shared outlets and do not belong to any single apartment.
- With the change in weather the THA Manager will be monitoring compliance to the outdoor storage of belongings. Elimination of any "playground" equipment, gazebos and wood fueled grills and smokers; as well as general clean up to avoid rodent/ pest problems.
 - Pools are not allowed. Sprinklers are okay, along with slip & slides (without a splash area or pool at the end).
 - Do not install swings on any kind on the laundry poles. These poles are not designed for this use. You put your child in danger by using these posts as a swing set.
 - Propane or electric grills only!! No charcoal or wood fired grills allowed. Grill must be 10 feet away from any building or structure when in use. Grill cooking surface cannot exceed 36 inches wide by 24 inches deep.
- Senior Van Service- This service is for City of Tonawanda residents only, 60 years of age or older. The van is available Tuesday through Friday beginning at 7:30am. Last pick up is 2:30pm. Contact the Parks and Rec office at 505-1172 for more information and to get an application
