- No pools of any kind or size are allowed on the THA property due to insurance regulations. Sprinklers, slip and slides or just a hose are okay.
- Porchlights, leave them on overnight to reduce the chances of an animal / rodent encounter as well as the possibility of petty crimes on the property. Our camera system works better when there is more light. Are you interested in a "dusk to dawn" lightbulb for your porch? These bulbs allow you to leave the light turned "on" at all times, but it doesn't come on until dark. Then it remains on through the night, shutting off at dawn. Contact the office if you are interested in having one installed on your porch.
- Parents Your help is needed!!! Please keep your children out of the parking lots. Please do not leave them unattended where they can wander into a parking lot. THA has installed additional signage and speed bumps for safety, but children need to be kept out of the parking lots by their parents.

Yard Maintenance

Please remove the following items by **<u>June 28, 2021</u>**:

- Birdfeeders, this is a food source for rodents and unwanted animals. If there is a bird feeder
 on the property it will be removed by THA.
- Pools, of any kind.
- Playground Equipment: swings, slides, playhouses, etc. If a child can fall off of it, it needs to be removed.
- Gazebos, screen houses, tents or 'homemade' awnings. Umbrellas that can be stowed away when not in use are permitted.
- Any and all miscellaneous items, including items that rodents and other unwanted animals
 could use as shelter and that are in the way of mowing operations.
