## Reminders

- Check your THA Tenant Manual for what is and what is not acceptable at [www.tonha.org](http://www.tonha.org)
- Pools of any kind are not allowed on THA property at any time. Sprinkler and slip and slides are approved for use. Please don't leave them running when not being used. Excess water usage leads to overall rent increases for every tenant on the property.
- Party tents (installed by a contractor) and bounce houses are not allowed on the THA property
- Grills are to be electric or propane only and cooking surfaces not to exceed 850 square inches. All others are not allowed on the property
- Fire pits are not allowed on THA property.
- Fireworks are not allowed on THA property. Due to the close proximity of buildings on the property this represents a health and safety issue for residents of THA.
- Electronics disposal – City of Tonawanda garbage (DPW) DOES NOT TAKE OLD ELECTRONICS AS GARBAGE!!! For recycling of old TV's check [www.SunKing.com](http://www.SunKing.com) for free electronic disposal sites. Hazman on Wales Ave in the COT will take your electronic FOR A FEE! Old tires can be disposed of at the DPW garage FOR A FEE. Old refrigerators and AC units are not recycled by COT either. Again, check with Hazman at [www.hazmanusa.com](http://www.hazmanusa.com) for disposal options and cost. If THA takes these items for disposal, there will be a charge to the tenant for disposal.
