- Overnight street parking ends in the City of Tonawanda on October 1, 2022 and remains in effect until March 31, 2023.
 - Make sure your vehicle is registered with the office and you park in your designated parking spot. Visitor passes are available 24/7 from the lobby of the Administration Building. Make sure you follow the instructions on the back of the Parking Pass.
- Remove window air conditioners by November 1, 2022. Tenant will be billed a service fee due to increased gas (heat) cost each month, as well as a charge for usage over your monthly allocation of gas.
- Text Alert program. Are you on the Alert List? We use this text communication to let tenants know when we are performing grass cutting operations and for Snow Removal Operations
- Review your Tenant Manual to understand your responsibilities for snow removal from your porch and sidewalk.
