- On street parking begins April 1st.
- Lawn cutting operations will begin soon. If THA is conducting grass cutting in your area, please go inside and take children inside for everyone's protection. A separate notification will follow later in the Spring.
 - Want to be notified when THA is cutting the grass? Sign up for text alerts to know when we are performing grass cutting operations.
- With the change in weather the THA Manager will be monitoring compliance to the outdoor storage of belongings. Elimination of any "playground" equipment, gazebos and wood fueled grills and smokers; as well as general clean up to avoid rodent/ pest problems.
 - Pools are not allowed. Sprinklers are okay, along with slip & slides (without a splash area or pool at the end).
 - Do not install swings of any kind on the laundry poles. These poles are not designed for this use. You put your child in danger by using these posts as a swing set.
 - Propane or electric grills only!! No charcoal or wood fired grills allowed. Grill must be 10 feet away from any building or structure when in use. Grill cooking surface cannot exceed 36 inches wide by 24 inches deep.
