- New yard rules. Please review, understand and follow the rules for storage of your belongings. Post Covid, where THA was lenient on this issue, has become an eyesore in many situations.
- Good Neighbor. Are you aware of the Good Neighbor portion of your Lease agreement? The purpose of the policy is to actually encourage tenants to discuss any issues or challenges presented in living in close quarters. Being able to speak to each other allows for problem resolution in a more communal way. Treating each other with respect is a big component of a strong Community.
- Water spigots. To clarify, these outdoor faucets are available for use to ANY tenant. There isn’t an “add on” charge to any particular tenant for usage out of that faucet, if it happens to be coming from your apartment. THA does not charge for water “overuse” by apartment as we do for natural gas.
- Pools, open fires / fire pits. All of these are not allowed on the property. The primary reason is insurance liability for THA. Open fire in a densely populated area like THA can be disastrous to people and buildings. The ability for a fire to spread because the buildings are close together is a very real risk.
- Fireworks. Not allowed on THA property. For the same reason as above, the risk of fire along with potential risk for injury to those in the area.
