- Text Alert. Sign up for Text Alerts to give you some notification of grass cutting operations. THA expects ALL outside storage to be kept in a manner as to NOT impede our grass cutting / weed whacking operations. THA discontinued the billing of weed whacking fees (look at your Tenant Manual, www.tonha.org) but we require Tenant cooperation. If we don't get cooperation, a Tenant should expect THA to bill them for non-compliance.
- We will begin grass cutting as soon as the ground is firm enough to support mowing operations. When grass cutting is underway, you may notice our operators stop and shut down the mower due to you being in the vicinity of their operations. Please leave the area or enter your apartment until we have completed grass cutting in your area.
- Contact the THA Office if you are considering planting a garden. We can advise what you can and cannot do in your area.
